The petitioner seeks grant of regular bail in case FIR No.110, dated 11.10.2015, registered under Sections 302/34 of the IPC, at Police Station Jhabhal, District Tarn Taran.

Counsel for the petitioner has argued that the petitioner has now been in custody since 27.10.2015 and that no specific role is attributed to the petitioner either in the FIR or in the final report.

Learned DAG Punjab, on instructions from ASI Jagdev

Singh, has accepted these factual assertions.

In these circumstances, without commenting upon the merits of the case, and keeping in view the period of custody already suffered by the petitioner, I do not deem it appropriate to deny the concession of regular bail to the petitioner.
