The petitioner seeks regular bail in case FIR No.319 dated 03.10.2015 registered under Sections 419, 420, 467, 468, 471, 120-B IPC at Police Station Tripri, District Patiala.

As per the prosecution version, the petitioner along with his co-accused has cheated the complainant party and induced them to part with huge amount of Rs.7 crore.

Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that the petitioner is in custody since 20.12.2015 and the investigation qua the petitioner has been concluded. He further submits that the matter is triable by the Judicial Magistrate.

Learned State counsel is not in a position to deny the said facts.

Be that as it may, keeping in view the period of custody already suffered by the petitioner and without going into the merits of the case, I do not deem it appropriate to deny him the concession of bail.

Patiala.
