This is a petition for the grant of regular bail in case bearing FIR No. 111 dated 24.10.2015, under Sections 302/148/149 IPC, subsequently converted to Section 304/34 IPC on 10.12.2015 and under Section 3/4 of the Scheduled Castes and Scheduled Tribes (Prevention of Atrocities) Act, 1989 added on 30.3.2016, registered at Police Station Malout City, District Muktsar.

Learned counsel has argued that one of the similarly situated co-accused namely Gaurav Bajaj has been granted the concession of anticipatory bail by this Court by order dated 20.05.2016 passed in CRM-M No. 6592 of 2016. He has further argued that petitioner No.1 has been in custody since 14.11.2015 and petitioner No.2 has been in custody since

23.12.2015. Learned DAG, on instructions from ASI Bira Singh, has accepted these factual assertions.

In the circumstances I see no reason to take a different view.

Let the petitioners be released on bail to the satisfaction of the trial Court.

Petition stands disposed of.

Since the main case has been decided, the Criminal Misc.Application, if any also stands disposed of.
