In a private complaint No.COMI/479/2014 dated 15.10.2013 titled 'Hardeep Kumar v/s Paramjit Singh etc.' filed by the complainant under Sections 326, 325, 323, 427, 148, 149, 506 IPC, the petitioner was granted ad-interim anticipatory bail by order dated 30.5.2016 made by this Court. Learned Counsel for the State has nothing to do obviously because this is a private complaint. Learned Counsel for the complainant has vehemently opposed the prayer for the grant of anticipatory bail on the ground that the injury was caused by datar on the left wrist of the complainant.

Be that as it may, the interim order dated 30.5.2016 is made absolute.
