On the instructions of ASI Surinder Singh it has been informed that the petitioners have joined investigation. Recovery of few bags has been effected. It is contended that the custodial interrogation of the petitioners is required for further recoveries.

I have considered the facts and circumstances of the case. The petitioners were involved in the case on the basis of the disclosure statements of co-accused Sikander and Vijay. As there are vague allegations of involvement of 15/20 persons in the FIR, therefore, the petitioners can be granted the concession of pre-arrest bail.

In view of the above, the petition is allowed and it is ordered that in case of arrest of the petitioners they will be released on bail to the satisfaction of the arresting officer subject to the conditions that the petitioners will join investigation as and when required by the police; they will not tamper with the evidence or hamper the investigation in any manner and that they will also not indulge in similar activity of which they are accused of, during the pendency of the trial.
