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KULDIP SINGH J. (ORAL)

Petitioner seeks quashing of FIR No.643, dated 16.10.2015, under Sections 186, 278, 506 and 120-B read with Section 34 IPC, registered as Police Station Samalkha, District Panipat.

Learned counsel for the petitioner contends that from the report filed under Section 173 Cr.P.C., the statement of witnesses recorded under Section 161 Cr.P.C. accompanied by the documents placed on file, no offence under Section 506 IPC is made out and the other offences are not cognizable against the present petitioner Rajesh Kumar Sharma.

In this case, challan has been presented. Let the petitioner raise all the available pleas before the lower court at the time of framing of charge. There is no ground to quash the FIR in question at this stage.

Accordingly, the present petition stands dismissed.
