By filing this petition, under Section 439 Cr.P.C the petitioner has sought regular bail in FIR No.36 dated 17.02.2015 under Sections 420, 467, 468 and 471 IPC registered at Police Station Dahka, District Ludhiana.

This Court on 03.06.2016 had passed the following order:-

“Petitioner seeks concession of regular bail in a case registered at the instance of Preeti Devi alleging that the petitioner had come in the capacity as an Advocate and handed over a fake order of the Court regarding implementation of Sixth Pay Commission and collected Rs. 4.5 lac as fee.

The counsel for the petitioner submits that the matter

has been compromised between complainant and Sant Kumar, the husband of complainant and the petitioner vide Annexure P-7.

Though the allegations against the petitioner are serious but in view of the fact that he has been in custody with effect from 11.02.2016, challan having already been presented and recoveries having already been made, petitioner can be released on interim bail till the decision of the petition for quashing on compromise. Petition for quashing on the basis of compromise is stated to be pending for 05.08.2016.

It is ordered that the petitioner will be released on interim bail on his furnishing bail bonds/surety bonds to the satisfaction of the trial Court/Duty Magistrate. The bail application on merits will be considered on 05.08.2016 along with the other petition after ascertaining whether the compromise has been effected between the petitioner and all the affected persons.”

Learned State counsel, on instructions from ASI Janak Raj, admits the factum of compromise.

In view of the above, the order dated 03.06.2016, passed by this Court is made absolute. The petitioner shall furnish fresh

bail bonds and surety bonds to the satisfaction of the trial Court.
