Under similar circumstances co-accused Baljinder Singh has been granted the concession of bail on 21.7.2014.

Counsel for the State has made an attempt to distinguish the case of Baljinder Singh with that of the petitioner, claiming that role attributed to the petitioner is different from that of Baljinder Singh. In the present case recovery of mobile telephone has been effected pursuant to his statement under under Section 27 of the Evidence Act.

Challan having already been presented and recovery having already been made, no useful purpose will be served by keeping the petitioner in custody.

The petition is allowed. The petitioner is ordered to be released on bail on his furnishing bail bond and surety bond to the satisfaction of the trial Court.
