2. In this case, reply in the shape of affidavit of Sh. Tarun Rattan, Deputy Superintendent of Police (D), Faridkot is already on record. According to the contents thereof, FIR in question bearing No.39, dated 04.04.2015, under Sections 324, 323, 148 and 149 IPC, Police Station City Kotkapura, has been deeply and thoroughly investigated by the police in professional manner and found that the allegations are false and baseless. Thus, cancellation report has been furnished.
