FATEH DEEP SINGH, J. (ORAL)

Report dated 05.07.2016 of learned Judicial Magistrate 1st

Class, Patti has been received whereby after recording statements of complainant Ranbir Singh and the accused persons namely Jaswant Singh alias Jassa, Harjinder Singh, Veerpal Kaur and Meenu, the Court has shown its satisfaction that the compromise has been arrived at voluntarily, out of free will of the parties, without any undue influence, coercion or pressure.

Heard.

In the light of the satisfaction shown by the Court, being a pure money dispute and a case of version and cross-version as also the

fact that offences for which the accused have been hauled up are not of serious nature, together with the fact that compromise will go a long way in ironing out differences for betterment of future life of the parties and in view of the law laid down in '**Gian Singh v. State of Punjab and another**' 2012(4) RCR (Criminal) 543 and '**Kulwinder Singh and others v. State of Punjab and another**' 2007 (3) RCR (Criminal) 1052, the prayer made in the petition is allowed, proceedings by way of rapat No.19 dated 12.10.2014 under Sections 326/323/506/34 IPC in case bearing FIR No.66 dated 10.10.2014 registered at Police Station Khalra, District Tarn Taran under Sections 365/323/34 IPC and all consequences arising out of the said rapat qua the petitioners are quashed.

The petition stands allowed in those terms.
