JASPAL SINGH, J. (ORAL)

The present petition has been filed under Section 482 Cr.P.C. for issuance of directions to respondents No.1 to 3 for presentation of final report under Section 173 Cr.P.C. in FIR No. 16 dated 12.10.2013, under Sections 420, 120-B IPC registered at P.S. NRI, District Ludhiana.

Though, FIR was initially registered at NRI, Ludhiana, subsequently, investigation of the case was transferred to Mohali which was conducted by Deputy

Superintendent of Police, SAS Nagar, Mohali.

Mr. J.S. Sekhon, Assistant Advocate General, Punjab, on instructions from SI Randhir Singh, has submitted that final report/cancellation report of the FIR has already been submitted in the Court of learned Chief Judicial Magistrate, Ludhiana. So, in view of the submission of the cancellation report/final report, no further action is required to be taken and instant petition has been rendered infructuous.

Accordingly, the present petition is dismissed as having been infructuous.
