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Learned Addl. A.G., Punjab, on instructions from Mr.Gurdev Singh, Assistant Engineer, RSD, Shahpurkhandi, has stated that respondent -workman was already taken back in service in compliance with award passed by labour Court. Hence, the present writ petition has become infructuous. She has further stated that however, lateron, he alongwith his wife died in a motor vehicle accident. She has further stated that dispute has since been settled regarding death of the workman with L.Rs of respondent No.1-workman. As per settlement, three bank drafts bearing Nos.919967, 919968 and 919969 all dated 03.11.2016, drawn on State Bank of India, Issuing Branch Jogial, Code No.03930, for ₹50,000/- (₹ Fifty Thousand Only) each have been brought by the official of the petitioners for being paid to all the three L.Rs, namely, Talab Hussain (son), Naziran (daughter) and Zarina (daughter) of the deceased-workman.

Mr.Ajay Nara, Advocate has appeared for L.Rs of respondent No.1-workman and has accepted all the three bank drafts for being delivered to L.Rs of the workman (deceased). He has also stated that the dispute with the department has since been settled and L.Rs of the deceased are having no other claim against the petitioners.
