This is the second application for the grant of pre-arrest bail.

Counsel for the petitioner submits that in reply to an enquiry letter by the Department of the petitioner, a letter has been received from Dr.Bhimrao Ambedkar University, Agra, that the petitioner had attended the classes.

With the assistance of counsel for the petitioner, I have gone through the letter addressed to the Revenue Department. A perusal of the said letter does not anywhere reflect that the petitioner had actually attended the classes and passed the examination and obtained the degree on the basis of which he has got appointment as Patwari.

No ground is made out to grant the concession of pre-arrest bail to the petitioner. The petition is dismissed.

Nothing said in this order will prejudice the right of the petitioner in any other proceedings pending before any other authority.
