This is an application for bringing on record the LRs of
Narotam Singh-respondent NO.3 who is stated to have died.

For the reasons recorded, the application is allowed subject to
all just exceptions. Persons mentioned in para No.2 be impleaded as legal
representatives of the deceased-respondent No.3. Registry is directed to
make necessary correction in the memo of parties.

F.A.O No.1000 of 1996

This appeal has been filed by the insurance company against the order dated 31.05.1995 passed by the Commissioner under the Workmen's Compensation Act, 1923, Hisar Circle on the ground that since the licence was fake the deceased could not have been employed as a driver.

Learned counsel for the appellant states that in this burnt case it is not clear as to whether the licence was 8725-K or 8725-H. As regards the licence 8725-K, the DTO Kamrup had informed that it was a fake licence but no report was obtained with regard to licence 8725-H.

I find from the record that though there was evidence which was placed on behalf of the claimants indicating that the licence was valid but the evidence which was led by the appellant to rebut it was of a different licence number and hence the argument that the licence was not valid has to be rejected.

In the circumstances, the appeal is dismissed.

Since the main case has been decided, the pending civil miscellaneous application, if any, also stands disposed of.
