Prayer in this petition filed under Section 482 Cr.P.C. is for quashing of FIR No.215 dated 19.12.2015, under Sections 307, 511, 336, 506, 34 IPC (Section 307 IPC added later on) and Section 25/27 of Arms Act, registered at Police Station Mehatpur, District Jalandhar.

Learned counsel for the petitioner states that the only allegation against the petitioner is that he has brought out the revolver from his pocket and straight away fired on the person of complainant but there was no injury as there is no medical legal report in the case. Therefore, no case under Section 307 IPC is made out.

On the other hand, learned State counsel on instructions from ASI Labh Singh states that in the case in hand the police has completed the investigation and accordingly, the challan has been presented.

In view of the fact that the police has completed the investigation and presented the challan, the present petition is dismissed with liberty to the petitioner to raise the plea at the time of framing of charge.
