This petition has been filed under Section 439 Cr.P.C. for grant of regular bail to the petitioners in case F.I.R. No.46 dated 24.03.2016 registered under Sections 323/341/506/308/148/149 IPC (Section 308 IPC added later) at Police Station Division No. 2, District Jalandhar.

On 08.07.2016 the following order was passed :-

“Learned counsel for the petitioners has argued that apart from the merits of the case the matter is between the close family members and has been compromised.

Learned DAG seeks a short adjournment to verify this

fact.

Adjourned to 19.07.2016.”

Learned Additional Advocate General on instructions from ASI Raminder Singh has accepted this fact.

Keeping in view the above facts and the period of incarceration already suffered by the petitioner No.2-Garish Kumar Joshi, without going into the merits of the case, I deem it appropriate to release the petitioner No.2 on regular bail to the satisfaction of CJM/Duty Magistrate, Kapurthala.

Ordered accordingly.

Petition stands disposed of .

Since the main case has been decided, the pending criminal miscellaneous application, if any, also stands disposed of.
