JASWANT SINGH, J (ORAL)

Prayer is under Section 438 Cr.PC for grant of anticipatory bail to the petitioner Pardeep Singh in case FIR No.140 dated 20.05.2014 for offence punishable under Section 20 of the NDPS Act registered with Police Station Chhehratta, District Amritsar City.

There was a recovery of 250 grams of Charas from the petitioner and he was enlarged on regular bail.

For his sole absence on 06.08.2015 his bail bonds were cancelled and NBWs were issued. He was later on declared proclaimed offender on 22.12.2015.

It is contended that non appearance on 6.8.2015 was on account of illness.

After hearing learned Counsel for the petitioner, no case for

grant of anticipatory bail to the petitioner is made out. No application seeking exemption from personal appearance on ground of illness was ever made. No material is available with the petitioner to substantiate the said plea. That apart the petitioner has now woken up after almost 08 months when he stands declared proclaimed offender by the trial Court and prays for anticipatory bail.

In view of the above, no ground for grant of anticipatory bail to the petitioner is made out.

Dismissed.
