Through the instant petition, the petitioner is seeking anticipatory bail in case FIR No.45 dated 11.04.2016, registered under Sections 406/498A of IPC, Police Station Women Cell, Distt. Patiala.

Mediation report has been received, according to which the parties have settled their dispute by way of an amicable settlement.

Learned counsel for the petitioner states that pursuant to the interim order date 31.05.2016, passed by this Court, the petitioner has joined the investigation and has cooperated and pursuant to compromise complainant has joined the company of petitioner.

Learned counsel appearing on behalf of complainant states that he has no information as to whether the complainant is living with the petitioner.

Learned State counsel on instructions from the concerned Investigating Officer has stated that the petitioner has joined the investigation.

Since the parties have settled the disputes, without commenting on the merits of the case, the petition is allowed and order dated 31.05.2016 granting interim bail to the petitioner is made absolute subject to the conditions laid down in Section 438 Sub Section 2 Clauses (i)(ii) and (iii) of the Code of Criminal Procedure.
