Petitioner has been in custody with effect from 20.11.2014 for having escaped leaving the car out of which seven bags of poppy husk containing 30 kg each was recovered. Petitioner is the registered owner of the vehicle.

Taking into consideration the fact the petitioner has been in custody for the last one year and ten months and he was not arrested along with the poppy husk, he having been arrested after nine months of the occurrence, he can be granted the concession of bail. Co-accused of the petitioner, similarly circumstanced, has been granted the concession of bail and no witness has been examined till date.

The petition is allowed. Petitioner is ordered to be released on bail on his furnishing bail bonds/surety bonds to the satisfaction of the trial Court.
