1. Whether reporters of local newspapers may be allowed to see judgment?

HARI PAL VERMA, J. (ORAL)

Prayer in this petition filed under Section 482 Cr.PC is for issuance of directions to respondents No.2 to 4 to protect the life and liberty of the petitioners at the hands of private respondents No.5 to 8.

Learned counsel for the petitioners contends that by virtue of the protection granted by this Court vide order dated 25.2.2016 passed in ***CRM-M-6836 of 2016*** titled as ***Shallu Sharma and another Versus Union Territory, Chandigarh and others***, petitioners Viney Sharma and Shallu Sharma are staying happily as husband and wife.

Learned counsel for the petitioners further contends that since

marriage of petitioners No.5 and 6 was solemnized against the wishes of respondents No.5 to 8, they made a complaint to the police, on the basis of which the petitioners are being harassed by the police. He further states that the petitioners have also approached respondent No.2 i.e. Senior Superintendent of Police, U.T., Chandigarh by way of application dated 27.5.2016 (Annexure P-5), but no action has been taken thereon by the police so far.

Notice of motion to respondents No.1 to 4 only at this stage.

On the asking of this Court, Mr. J.S. Toor, Assistant Public Prosecutor, U.T., Chandigarh accepts notice on behalf of these respondents.

Learned counsel for the petitioners is directed to hand over requisite number of complete copies of the paper book to learned State counsel during course of the day.

Heard.

Without commenting upon the merits of the case, the present petition is disposed of with a direction to respondent No.2 to take note of the contents of application (Annexure P-5) and to act in accordance with law.
