ANITA CHAUDHRY, J.

This is the petitioner seeking anticipatory bail in FIR No. 14 dated 25.08.2015, registered under Sections 406, 498 IPC, Police Station NRI, District SAS Nagar, Mohali.

Both the parties are present. The petitioner has returned to India on the last date. He was asked to return within five days, failing which his petition would be dismissed.

Counsel for the complainant states that the articles have not been returned. This fact is disputed by the other side. The State counsel says that the bills pertaining to the jewellery remain to be returned and is worth lacs.

Counsel for the petitioner says that petitioner is ready to furnish security for two lacs.

Counsel for the complainant says that the petitioner had violated the order passed by this Court earlier and he had to return in October and it is only after the directions were given by this Court he has returned and he would leave the country again.

Petitioner has joined the investigation. He is ready to offer security. Looking to all these circumstances, but without commenting on the merits of the case, the petition is allowed and order dated 31.05.2016 granting interim bail to the petitioner is made absolute subject to the conditions laid down in Section 438 Sub Section 2 Clauses (i)(ii) and (iii) of the Code of Criminal Procedure. The petitioner would also furnish security in the sum of Rs.2 lacs before the trial Court. Petitioner would not leave the country without the prior permission of the trial Court. He would also place the copy of the passport with the trial Court.
