Prayer in this petition filed under Section 482 Cr.PC is for handing over the investigation of DDR No.15 dated 31.10.2015 recorded at Police Station Bhupani, District Faridabad to a competent independent agency.

Learned counsel for the petitioner contends that brother of the petitioner died in mysterious circumstances regarding which the aforesaid DDR was recorded by the police. He further states that the petitioner has also approached respondent No.2 i.e. Commissioner of Police, Faridabad by way of representation dated 16.11.2015 (Annexure P-2), but no action has

been taken by the police so far.

On the asking of this Court, Mr. Sulinder Kumar, AAG, Haryana accepts notice on behalf of the respondents.

Learned counsel for the petitioner is directed to hand over requisite number of complete copies of the paper book to learned State counsel during course of the day.
