HARI PAL VERMA, J. (ORAL)

There is no appearance on behalf of the petitioner. Even on the last date of hearing, nobody was present on behalf of the petitioner.

Prayer in this petition is for issuance of a direction to respondent No.2 i.e. SHO P.S. Kila Lal Singh, Batala, District Gurdaspur not to call the petitioner to the Police Station and to harass her.

Learned State counsel has filed reply by way of affidavit of Kirpal Singh, PPS, DSP, Sub Division Fatehgarh Churian, Police District Batala, which is taken on record. On the strength of reply, learned State counsel submits that the averments made in the petition are false. The

petitioner is neither required nor was called in the Police Station. She was not arrested or detained in the lock up on 18.2.2015 and 19.2.2015 as averred in the petition. Moreover, the petitioner has never filed any complaint or representation to respondent No.1 or to any other senior police officer regarding her illegal detention on 18.2.2015 and 19.2.2015.

Taking into consideration the reply wherein the contents of the petition have been denied in its totality, no order is required to be passed in the present petition.

Dismissed as such.
