KULDIP SINGH, J (ORAL)

The prayer in this present petition filed under Section 482 of Cr. P.C is for quashing of FIR No. 128 dated 03.09.2014 (*Annexure P-1*) registered under Sections 420 of IPC at Police Station Sarhali, District Tarn Taran, Punjab alongwith all subsequent proceedings arising therefrom on the basis of compromise (*Annexure P-2*).

The report of the learned Judicial Magistrate Ist Class, Tarn Taran has also been received wherein it has been reported that the statements of the complainant and accused have been recorded. It is further reported that compromise has been effected between the parties and the said compromise is voluntary and is without any coercion, pressure or undue influence.

Since, the parties have amicably settled their dispute, therefore, FIR No. 128 dated 03.09.2014 registered under Sections 420 of IPC at Police Station Sarhali, District Tarn Taran, Punjab stands quashed alongwith all subsequent proceedings arising therefrom, on the basis of compromise.

In view of the above, the petition is allowed.
