JASPAL SINGH, J.

This petition has been preferred under Section 482 of the Code of Criminal Procedure for quashing of FIR No. 175, dated 26.11.2013, under Sections 279, 337, 338 & 427 of IPC, registered at Police Station Model Town Hoshiarpur, District Hoshiarpur, (**Annexure P-1**) along with all consequential proceedings arising out of the same on the basis of compromise dated May 01, 2015 (**Annexure P-2**).

2. In compliance of order dated September 07, 2015, statement of the parties have been recorded by the trial Court.

Report of learned Chief Judicial Magistrate, Hoshiarpur, has been received, in which, it has been categorically observed that parties have arrived at compromise without any pressure, voluntarily or coercion from any quarter. Even otherwise, matter involved is personal in nature, which has been amicably put at rest.

3. In view of the above I am of the considered opinion that continuation of criminal proceedings between the parties would be an abuse of the process of law and the present compromise is for their benefit and will bring peace and harmony between them.

4. Consequently, instant petition stands allowed and FIR No. 175, dated 26.11.2013, under Sections 279, 337, 338 & 427 of IPC, registered at Police Station Model Town Hoshiarpur, District Hoshiarpur, and all other subsequent proceedings arising therefrom are quashed qua the petitioner.
