This is a petition for grant of pre-arrest bail to the petitioner under Section 438 Cr.P.C. in case FIR No.32 dated 23.02.2014 registered under Sections 379 IPC and 21 (3) Mines and Mineral Act, 1957 at Police Station Ghall Khurd, District Ferozepur.

On 01.06.2016 the following order was passed :-

“Counsel would submit that the petitioner had been admitted to bail but on account of a health ailment, had absented only on one date i.e. 12.5.2016. It is further submitted that on the very next day i.e. on 13.5.2016 he had appeared before the Trial Court but the concession of bail

was canceled and bail bonds were forfeited.

Notice of motion, returnable for 14.9.2016.

In the meantime, it is directed that in case the petitioner duly appears before the Trial Court on 3.6.2016 i.e. the date already fixed, he would be entitled to interim bail subject to satisfaction of the Trial Court.”

Learned counsel for the petitioner states that the petitioner has surrendered before the trial Court and has been granted interim bail.

In this view of the matter, I do not deem it appropriate to deny the prayer. The trial Court shall confirm the bail application subject to whatever security it deems fit.

Petition stands allowed.

Since the main case has been decided, the pending criminal miscellaneous application, if any, also stands disposed of.
