AMIT RAWAL, J. (ORAL)

The petitioner is tried under Section 21 of the NDPS Act in respect of FIR No.25 dated 23.03.2016 registered at Police Station Sadar Rajpura, District Patiala, for allegedly smuggling of the heroine.

Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that accused was found to be in the custody of the heroine in Taxi bearing Registration No.DL-1YD-2388, owned by the petitioner, but the Taxi at the relevant time was driven by the Driver Anil Kumar. He submits that there is no other case registered against the petitioner, in this regard.

Learned State Counsel submits that even if, the petitioner is not found to be in the custody of the heroine, allegation against him is that he is supplying drugs.

Without commenting on the merits and demerits of the case, I am of the view that the petitioner is in custody since, 23.03.2016 and accordingly, the petitioner is ordered to be released on bail on his furnishing bail bonds/surety bonds to the satisfaction of CJM/Duty Magistrate, Patiala.

The petition is allowed.
