JASPAL SINGH, J.

This petition has been preferred under Section 482 of the Code of Criminal Procedure for quashing of FIR No. 29, dated April 17, 2011, under Sections 307, 451, 323, 324, 325, 380, 148, 149 IPC, registered at Police Station Sadar Kapurthala, District Kapurthala (**Annexure P-1**) along with all consequential proceedings arising out of the same on the basis of compromise May 17, 2014 (**Annexure P-2**).

2. Report of learned Additional District & Sessions Judge, Kapurthala, has been received, in which, it has been categorically observed that parties have arrived at compromise without any influence, coercion and the same appears to be genuine. Even otherwise, matter involved is personal in nature, which has been amicably put at rest.

3. In view of the above, I am of the considered opinion that continuation of criminal proceedings between the parties would be an abuse of the process of law and the present compromise is for their benefit and will bring peace and harmony between them.

4. Consequently, instant petition stands allowed and FIR No. 29, dated April 17, 2011, under Sections 307, 451, 323, 324, 325, 380, 148, 149 IPC, registered at Police Station Sadar Kapurthala, District Kapurthala (**Annexure P-1**) and all other subsequent proceedings arising therefrom are quashed qua the petitioners.
