Instant petition has been preferred under Section 482 of the Code of Criminal Procedure seeking issuance of appropriate directions or order to official respondents No. 1 to 4 to protect the life and liberty of the petitioner and his family members, who are under the constant threat of their lives due to repeated attacks upon them by private respondents No. 5 to 13 and their associates.

2. Notice of motion to respondents No. 1 to 4 only, at this stage.
3. On the asking of Court, Mr. K.S. Pannu, DAG, Punjab has accepted notice on behalf of respondents-State. Copy of the petition has been supplied to learned State counsel.

4. Learned counsel for the petitioner *inter alia* contends that though various representations were moved to official respondents including representation dated 27.05.2016 (Annexure P-13) but till date no action has been taken.

5. The instant petition is disposed of with direction to respondent No.2- Commissioner of Police, Amritsar City, Punjab, to inquire into the grievances unfolded by the petitioner in his representation dated 27.05.2016 (Annexure P-13) and if some substance is found, to take appropriate action in accordance with law within a period of two months from the date of receipt of certified copy of this order and if concerned police official found that there is threat perception to the life and liberty of the petitioner as well as of his family members, he shall provide the necessary protection, if so required.
