Learned counsel for the appellant submits that despite best efforts being made by the appellant-Company, to trace out the legal heirs of Dhian Singh, respondent No.3, who is stated to have died, as also to trace out the addresses of the other respondents, the appellant-Company has not been able to do so. Respondent No.4 had been served but none has appeared on its behalf today. Learned counsel submits that the case file of this appeal had been burnt in the fire incident which took place in January, 2011. However, after the file was reconstructed (as can be seen from the order sheets), fresh notices were ordered to be issued to the respondents on 06.03.2014.

Two years have gone by since then and in view of the fact that the addresses of the respondents are not traceable, despite the best efforts stated to have been made by the appellant-Company, the present appeal is dismissed for non-prosecution.
