Prayer in this application is for exemption from filing certified copies of Annexures P-1 to P-4 and placing on record the true typed copies of the same.

For the reasons stated in the application, the same is allowed and documents Annexures P-1 to P-4 are taken on record subject to all just exceptions.

CRM-M-19606-2016

Prayer in this petition filed under Section 482 Cr.PC is for issuance of a direction to the official respondents to investigate the matter in case FIR No.74 dated 12.8.2015 under Sections 323 and 324 read with

Section 34 IPC (Section 326 IPC added later on) registered at Police Station
Haryana, District Hoshiarpur.

Learned counsel for the petitioner contends that though the FIR
was registered on 12.8.2015 and about 9 months have passed, but no action
has been taken thereon. He further states that in order to get speedy
investigation, the petitioner has already approached respondent No.3 i.e.
Senior Superintendent of Police, Hoshiarpur by way of representation dated
18.12.2015 (Annexure P-4), but no action has been taken thereon.

Notice of motion to respondents No.1 to 5 only at this stage.

On the asking of this Court, Mr. Sultan Singh Gill, DAG,
Punjab accepts notice on behalf of these respondents.

Learned counsel for the petitioner is directed to hand over
requisite number of complete copies of the paper book to learned State
counsel during course of the day.

Heard.

Without commenting upon the merits of the case, the present
petition is disposed of with a direction to respondent No.3 to take note of the
contents of representation (Annexure P-4) and to act in accordance with law
as early as possible.
