This is a petition for quashing of FIR on the basis of compromise.

Learned counsel for the complainant has submitted that he is ready to depose true facts by voluntarily appearing before the Investigating Officer and he has no objection in case the criminal proceedings qua the petitioners are dropped. The investigation is still in initial stage.

This petition is disposed of at this stage with a direction that complainant will appear before the Investigating Officer and offer a supplementary statement. Statement of any other witness, voluntarily made, may also be recorded by the Investigating Officer under the mandate of Section 163 (2) of the Code of Criminal Procedure. It will be open to the Investigating Officer thereafter to prepare a cancellation report and submit the same before the Area Magistrate which can be dealt with on the basis of no objection furnished by the complainant.

Report in this context be submitted before this Court on 29.9.2016.
