For having been found in possession of 100 gms. of intoxicating powder containing dyphenoxylate hydrochloride, the petitioner had been granted the concession of interim bail till the receipt of report of chemical examiner.

After expiry of said period, the petitioner instead of surrendering sought the concession of pre-arrest bail.

Counsel for the petitioner submits that petitioner is an old lady who had two sons and both have expired. She has to look after other family members and she has not misused the concession of bail.

I have considered the contentions of the counsel for the petitioner. The circumstances mentioned by the counsel for the petitioner may constitute good ground for the grant of regular bail to the petitioner after surrendering in compliance with the terms of the interim bail which was only till receipt of report of chemical examiner.

The petition is dismissed without prejudice to the right of the petitioner to surrender before the Special Judge and seek concession of regular bail in accordance with law. All the pleas taken up in this petition may be raised before the Court concerned
