The petitioner is seeking anticipatory bail in FIR No. 331 dated 25.04.2016 under Sections 498-A, 406, 323 and 506 IPC registered at Police Station Sadar, Hisar.

In compliance of order dated, 25.10.2016, learned counsel for U.T.Chandigarh has produced ACRs of five years of the petitioner. As per status report, the investigating officer visited the Gupta Hospital, Sector 14, Hisar as well as Gupta Medical Centre, Prem Nagar, Hisar for collecting the record pertaining to the health of mother of respondent No.2, but the doctor of the Gupta Hospital, Sector-14, Hisar and Gupta Medical Centre, Prem Nagar, Hisar stated that the mother of respondent No.2 was never admitted in the Hospital and as such there is no record pertaining to her treatment available in the hospital. Reports of Investigating Officer are annexed as Annexures R-1 and R-2. As per posting records of Insps/NGO's and OR's in the PEB Branch and ACRs of the petitioner, he is found to intelligent, honest and disciplined.

Learned State counsel states that the complainant has refused to accept dowry articles on 26.04.2016 and the petitioner has joined investigation in terms of order dated 01.06.2016.

Keeping in view the status report dated 30.11.2016 and the submissions made by learned State counsel, order dated 01.06.2016 is made absolute.

Petition stands disposed of accordingly.
