Prayer made in the present petition filed under Section 438 Cr.P.C. is for grant of anticipatory bail to the petitioners in case FIR No.34, dated 15.04.2015, for offence punishable under Sections 302, 148, 149 of IPC and Sections 25 and 27 of the Arms Act, registered at Police Station Badhni Kalan, District-Moga.

Learned counsel for the petitioners contends that pursuant to the order dated 01.06.2016, passed by this Court, the petitioners have surrendered before the learned trial Court and have been admitted on interim bail on their furnishing requisite bail bonds. He has produced a photocopy of the order dated 07.06.2016 passed by learned Addl. Sessions Judge, Moga whereby the petitioners-accused have been admitted on interim bail. The said order is taken on record.

Learned counsel for the State does not dispute the aforesaid fact.

Keeping in view of the fact that the petitioners have surrendered before the learned trial Court and learned trial Court has admitted them on interim bail, order dated 01.06.2016, passed by this Court, is made absolute.

The petition disposed of accordingly.
