Instant petition has been preferred under Section 482 of the Code of Criminal Procedure seeking issuance of directions to respondent No.2 to initiate appropriate proceeding under Section 182 IPC against respondent No.4 for making various false complaints against the petitioner time and again with a vested motive, which was found to be false in various enquiries by different officials.

2. Notice of motion to respondents No. 1 to 3 only, at this stage.
3. On the asking of Court, Mr. K.S. Pannu, DAG, Punjab has accepted notice on behalf of respondents-State. Copy of the petition has been supplied to learned State counsel.

4. Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that though representation dated 11.05.2016 (Annexure P-4) was moved to respondents No. 2 and 3 but till date no action has been taken.

5. The instant petition is disposed of with direction to respondent No.3- Senior Superintendent of Police Rural, District Amritsar, Punjab, to inquire into the grievances unfolded by the petitioner in his representation dated 11.05.2016 (Annexure P-4) and if some substance is found, to take appropriate action in accordance with law within a period of two months from the date of receipt of certified copy of this order.
