Prayer made in the present petition filed under Section 482 Cr.P.C. is for transfer of investigation of case FIR No.75 dated 18.03.2008, under Sections 307, 506, 427, 34 IPC and read with Sections 25 & 27 of the Arms Act, registered at Police Station Kharar, Distt. SAS Nagar Mohali to Crime Branch, Punjab headquarter at Chandigarh.

Learned counsel for the petitioner has argued that though the FIR was registered on 18.03.2008, but the police has not completed the investigation.

On the other hand, learned State counsel, on instructions from ASI-Ashok Kumar and on the basis of reply dated 16.09.2015 submits that after getting proper sanction from the competent authorities, the Investigating Officer of the case has presented the cancellation report in the aforesaid FIR before the learned Judicial Magistrate Ist Class, Kharar on two different occasions, however, the same was returned back by the

learned Magistrate with a direction to further investigate the matter. Now, the matter is under investigation with the police authorities.

After hearing learned counsel for the parties and without making any observation on the merits of the case, present petition is disposed of with a direction to SSP, Mohali to supervise the investigations of the case.

However, it would be appreciated if the investigation is completed within six months.
