Prayer in this petition is for grant of anticipatory bail to the petitioners in FIR No.65 dated 4.4.2013, under Sections 419, 420, 120-B IPC (offence under Sections 465, 467, 468 and 471 IPC added later on), registered at Police Station Division No.5, Civil Lines, Ludhiana.

This Court vide order dated 2.6.2016, while issuing notice of motion, has granted interim bail to the petitioners subject to joining the investigation as and when directed by the Investigating Agency/Investigating Officer and to abide by the terms and conditions laid down under Section 438(2) Cr.P.C.

Learned counsel for the petitioners contends that pursuant to order dated 2.6.2016, the petitioner have joined the investigation.

Learned State counsel, who is assisted by ASI Rajinder Kumar, has stated that in terms of the above order the petitioner has joined investigation and their custodial interrogation is not required.

In view of the above, the present petition is allowed and interim directions issued by this Court vide order dated 2.6.2016 are made absolute.

However, the petitioners shall continue to join investigation as and when required to do so and shall abide by the terms and conditions, as laid down under Section 438(2) Cr.P.C.
