Prayer in this petition filed under Section 482 Cr.P.C. for a direction to respondents No.2 and 3 is to protect the life and liberty of petitioners by providing adequate security/police protection to them as they apprehend threat to their lives at the hands of respondents No.4 to 7.

The State counsel has produced photocopies of statements of respondents No.4 to 7 to the effect that they have no objection if the petitioners have got married.

Without expressing any opinion on the validity of the marriage and considering the statements of private respondents i.e. respondents No.4 to 7, the present petition is disposed of as having become infructuous. However, still in case the petitioners apprehend threat to their lives and liberty, they are at liberty to approach the concerned S.S.P. for redressal of their grievance, if any.
