HARI PAL VERMA, J.(Oral)

Prayer in this petition filed under Section 482 Cr.P.C. is for quashing of FIR No.25, dated 18.03.2011, registered under Section 188 IPC at Police Station Bholath, District Kapurthala and the subsequent proceedings arising therefrom.

Learned counsel for the petitioner contends that though the FIR, in question, was registered on 18.03.2011 and thereafter, the police has prepared a cancellation report but the same has not been submitted to the Court.

Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that the petitioner would be satisfied in case a direction is issued to expedite the investigation.
