This order will dispose of two petitions, one CRM-M-19799-2016, filed by Gurpreet Singh @ Gopi and Bhupinderjit Singh @ Bobby, and the other CRM-M-19807-2016, filed by Manpreet Singh @ Mani, Ranjit Singh @ Bagga, Gagandeep Singh @ Magan and Mandeep Singh, under Section 482 Cr.P.C. for quashing of FIR No. 95, dated 25.12.2015, for the offences punishable under Sections 148, 149, 323, 324 and 451 I.P.C., registered at Police Station Bholath, District Kapurthala, as well as DDR No. 25, dated 26.12.2015, for the offences punishable under Sections 323, 324 and 341 IPC, in the above mentioned FIR, registered at Police Station Bholath, District Kapurthala, and all the subsequent proceedings arising thereof, on the basis of compromise.

Learned State counsel on the instructions of ASI Raghbir Singh informs that the cancellation report in the FIR as well as in the cross-version case has already been prepared.

In view of the said circumstances, both these petitions are disposed of with a direction that the parties shall appear before the Illaqa Magistrate, with no objection to the respective cancellation reports, to enable the said Court to pass an appropriate order to accept the cancellation reports.

It will be appreciated in case, the entire process is completed within a period of two months.
