Instant petition has been preferred under Section 482 of the Code of Criminal Procedure seeking issuance of an appropriate order or directions to respondents No. 1 to 4 to protect the life, liberty and properties of the petitioner at the hands of respondents No. 5 to 8, who in connivance with each other forcibly, illegally and unauthorizedly harvested the wheat crops of the petitioner on 20.04.2016 with further prayer to direct the official respondents to take an appropriate action on the application dated 21.04.2016 (Annexure P-4) against the private respondents No. 5 to 8.

2. Notice of motion to respondents No. 1 to 4 only, at this stage.

3. On the asking of Court, Mr. Sidakmeet Singh Sandhu, AAG, Punjab has accepted notice on behalf of respondents-State. Copy of the petition has been supplied to learned State counsel.

4. Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that though application/representation dated 21.04.2016 (Annexure P-4) was moved to Deputy Commissioner of Police, Bathinda but till date no action has been taken.

5. The instant petition is disposed of with direction to respondent No.3- Senior Superintendent of Police, Bathinda, to inquire into the grievances unfolded by the petitioner in her application/representation dated 21.04.2016 (Annexure P-4) and if some substance is found, to take appropriate action in accordance with law within a period of three months from the date of receipt of certified copy of this order.
