Through the instant petition, the petitioner is seeking anticipatory bail in case FIR No. 171 dated 07.03.2015, registered under Sections 147, 148, 149, 323, 354-B, 307 IPC, Section 3 of SC/ST Act, Section 25 of Arms Act and Section 8 of POCSO Act, Police Station Hodal, District Palwal.

State counsel states that Section 307 IPC is not attributed to the petitioners and case under Section 174-A IPC has also been registered against the petitioners.

Counsel for the petitioners has placed on record copy of the order dated 31.05.2016 vide which the petitioners were declared proclaimed offenders. He states that the petitioners are ready to appear before the trial Court.

The petitioners are directed to appear before the trial Court. On doing so, the trial Court shall admit them on interim bail on their furnishing bonds to its satisfaction.
