Kuldip Singh, J. (Oral):

Present petition was filed by the petitioner stating that he has lodged FIR No.9 dated 14.1.2015 under Section 420 IPC, at PS Kotwali, Faridkot. According to the petitioner, the case is not being properly investigated, therefore, the prayer was made for transferring the case for investigation to some senior Police Officer not below the rank of Superintendent of Police and under the supervision of Inspector General of Police, Bathinda Zone, Bathinda – respondent No.2.

Learned State counsel, on instructions from ASI Balwinder Singh, has informed that the investigation of this case is already complete and challan has been presented before the trial court on 18.1.2016.

It being so, the present petition is disposed of with liberty to the petitioner to raise all the available pleas before the lower court regarding his allegations that incomplete challan has been presented. If such plea is raised, the trial court shall decide the same in accordance with law.

Liberty is also given to the petitioner to file a criminal complaint if he so desires. If such complaint is filed, the same shall be tried jointly with the State case.
