Instant petition has been preferred under Section 439 Cr.P.C. by Gurpreet Singh seeking regular bail in case FIR No. 429 dated November 24, 2014 under Section 22 of NDPS Act registered at Police Station City, Tarn Taran, District Tarn Taran.

Undisputably, petitioner was granted an interim bail vide order dated February 24, 2015 on account of the fact that report of FSL has not been received. Subsequently, on receipt of report dated July 17, 2015, the afore-said order granting interim bail to the petitioner has since been cancelled by learned

trial Court vide order dated December 01, 2015. After the cancellation of interim bail, petitioner did not approach learned trial Court for regular bail on merits and has approached this Court by way of instant petition.

Instant petition is disposed of with a direction to petitioner to approach learned trial Court for grant of regular bail on merits and if he so aggrieved by an order passed by learned trial Court, he shall be at liberty to approach this Court.
