By filing the present petition under Section 438 of the Code of Criminal Procedure, the petitioner has sought anticipatory bail in FIR No.251 dated 27.10.2015, registered under Sections 323, 328, 341, 306 and 307 read with Section 34 of IPC, at Police Station City Jagraon, District Ludhiana Rural.

On 03.11.2016, this Court had passed the following order:-

“Contends that the allegations against the petitioner and his co-accused are of causing injuries and forcibly administering poison to the deceased. He refers to the post-mortem report wherein, except the bruise, no other injury was found on the person of the deceased.

The petitioner is allowed to join the investigation.

Post again on 22.12.2016.

Meanwhile, in the event of arrest of the petitioner by the Arresting Officer, he shall be released on interim bail subject to the following conditions:-

- 1. That he shall make himself available for interrogation by a police officer as and when required;*
- 2. That he shall not directly or indirectly make any inducement, threat or promise to any person acquainted with the facts of the case so as to dissuade him from disclosing such facts to the Court or to any police officer and;*
- 3. That he shall not leave India without previous permission of the Court.”*

It is contended that in pursuance of the order dated 03.11.2016, the petitioner has joined the investigation

The learned State counsel, on instructions submits that the petitioner has joined the investigation and he is not required for custodial interrogation.

In view of the above, without expressing any opinion on the merits of the case, the interim bail granted by this Court vide order dated 03.11.2016, is made absolute, subject to furnishing bail bonds/surety bonds to the satisfaction of learned Chief Judicial Magistrate/Duty Magistrate, concerned.

The petition stands allowed.
