This petition has been filed under Section 439 Cr.P.C. for
grant of regular bail to the petitioner in case FIR No.87 dated

11.04.2015, registered under Sections 302, 201, 460, 473, 482, 120 and

34 IPC, at Police Station Tripuri, Patiala.

Learned counsel for the petitioner states that the petitioner has been in custody for the last more than 1 year & 2 months and his case is better than the co-accused Bachhittar Singh who was granted bail by order dated 20.05.2016 in CRM-M-10383-2016.

Learned Assistant Advocate General has argued that the wallet of the deceased was recovered from the petitioner.

Be that as it may, keeping in view the above facts and the period of incarceration already suffered by the petitioner, without going into the merits of the case, I deem it appropriate to release the petitioner on regular bail to the satisfaction of the trial Court/Duty Magistrate.

Ordered accordingly.

Petition stands allowed.

Since the main case has been decided, the pending criminal miscellaneous application, if any, also stands disposed of.
