Prayer in this petition filed under Section 438 Cr.P.C. is for grant of anticipatory bail to the petitioners in case FIR No.48 dated 20.04.2014 under Sections 420, 467, 468, 471 and 120-B IPC, registered at Police Station Payal, District Ludhiana.

This Court vide order dated 04.08.2016, while issuing notice of motion, has granted ad-interim bail to the petitioners subject to joining the investigation as and when directed by the Investigating Agency/Investigating Officer and to abide by the terms and conditions laid down under Section 438(2) Cr.P.C.

Learned counsel for the petitioners contends that pursuant to order dated 04.08.2016, petitioners have joined the investigation.

Learned State counsel, who is assisted by ASI Amrik Singh has stated that in terms of above order, petitioners have joined investigation and

their custodial interrogation is not required.

In view of the above, the present petition is allowed and interim directions issued by this Court vide order dated 04.08.2016 are made absolute.

However, the petitioners shall continue to join investigation as and when required to do so and shall abide by the terms and conditions, as laid down under Section 438(2) Cr.P.C.
