By this petition the petitioner has sought direction to the official respondent Nos.3 and 4 to not interfere in the peaceful life of the petitioner and not to force the petitioner and his family members for compromising the matter with respondents No.5 to 8 under undue influence and pressure.

Learned counsel for the petitioner states that in this

connection he has also moved a representation dated 10.05.2016 (Annexure P-1) and at this stage he would be satisfied if a direction is given to respondent No.2 to look into the matter and take appropriate action on his representation within any reasonable time.

I find this to be a fair request. The respondent No.2- the SSP, Mansa is directed to look into the matter and in case it is found that any action is required, to take whatever action he deems necessary as per law.

Petition stands disposed of in the above terms.

Since the main case has been decided, the pending criminal miscellaneous application, if any, also stands disposed of.
