**JASPAL SINGH, J.(ORAL)**

By virtue of instant petition preferred under Section 438 Cr.P.C., petitioner has sought pre-arrest bail in case FIR No.123 dated 23.11.2011, under Sections 406, 420, 120-B IPC registered at Police Station Division No.4, Ludhiana, District Ludhiana.

At the time of issuance of notice of motion on July 08, 2016, following order was passed by this Court:

*“Notice of motion to the respondents for  
22.08.2016.*

*Meanwhile, the petitioner is directed to  
appear/surrender before the ld. trial court/Duty  
Magistrate within a period of 7 days from today and on  
her appearance, she shall be released on interim bail to  
the satisfaction of ld. Trial court/Duty Magistrate”.*

On instructions from ASI Mukhtiar Singh, learned State counsel has submitted that petitioner has already joined the investigation before the trial Court on 1<sup>st</sup> August, 2016 and has been released on interim bail. Petitioner is no more required for further interrogation as he has joined the proceedings before the trial Court. The trial is not likely to be

disposed of within short span of time.

Accordingly, petition is allowed and order dated July 8, 2016 is made absolute and shall enure till the final proceeding of the trial.
